TRASH PICKUP & RECYCLING PICKUP IS EVERY TUESDAY

Memorial Day is May 26, so Pickup will be Wednesday May 30, 2018.

Labor Day is September 3rd so Pickup will be Wednesday September 5th, 2018.

Christmas is Tuesday this year, so Pickup will be Wednesday, December 26, 2018.

Garbage Cart Rules Advanced Disposal 1-888-688-4005

Place container:

- On the curb line with the arrows on the cover facing the street.
- Within 1 foot of the road's edge.
- 3 feet from mailbox or light pole.
- Away from low wires.
- Carts should be 3 feet from each other.
- Lids need to be closed.
- Carts should be placed in current location on service day.
- Garbage should be bagged to keep material from blowing away when cart is dumped.
- All material needs to be in the proper cart.
- All material needs to be inside the cart for disposal.

It does not matter what color of bag you use for garbage now. Advanced wants you to bag your garbage, but you do not need to put a liner in the cart.

Each cart has a serial number on them that corresponds to your address. The carts are property of Advanced Disposal. Do not take them if you move from your address.

These carts are free to us now. If you damage your carts (drive over it, abuse it, burn it, or anything else to damage it), you will have to pay approximately \$70.00 to \$90.00 to replace it.

Recycling items can all be put together in the yellow covered recycling cart. Don't use a bag for recycling items now, just the recycling items go in the recycling cart. (This will include paper, cardboard, all plastics, all tin and all aluminum). Be sure to note the items that cannot be recycled and put them in your garbage bags. Call if you have questions and we will find the answer.

Bulky Garbage Disposal

Ways to get rid of bulky items:

- 1) Rent a dumpster from the Village or from any local garbage hauler. You must call for information.
- 2) Take your items to the United Ministries Thrift Store here in the Village, 920-773-3050. They will pick up too.
- 3) Haul your items to Ridgeview Landfill, 920-732-447,3 or Hickory Meadows Landfill, 920-853-8553. Call ahead for costs.

- 4) Contact Mike Plate, 920-323-5110. He will pick up all unwanted scrap metal: washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, water heaters, sheet metal, heavy iron, cast iron sinks and bath tubs, car parts, batteries, rotors, rims, electric motors, wiring, copper pipe, steel pipe, brass, aluminum, lawnmowers, snow blowers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, and any appliance or metal as long as it has a cord on it. He does charge a fee for TV's based on size, and refrigerators and freezers. Call Mike with questions and fees.
- 5) The Village of Whitelaw will have a truck at their recycling center May 12th, 1-3pm. (920-732-3239)
- 6) Contact D&D Enterprise – Dean Konsela, 920-758-2677. He also picks up many of the items listed above, but there may be a cost. Call ahead with questions or list of items to be sure he will pick them up and cost. TV's picked up for cost, also will help with major organization or removal of items in basements, garages or houses. Call for costs.
- 7) Be sure to watch the papers for the local clean sweeps that the county holds to get rid of paints, chemicals, medications, etc.
- 8) Call the Village Office, 773-2471, or Advanced Disposal, 920-849-9544, with questions.

Brush Drop Off Site

PLEASE!

- No garbage bags of any type are allowed at the site. No bags whatsoever!
- No dog feces allowed! Put dog feces in your garbage.

If violations continue, you will force us to close the drop off site and you will have to haul your brush to Manitowoc.
