OVERNIGHT WINTER PARKING BAN

No person shall leave standing any vehicle upon any village street between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from **December 1 through April**

1. This will be strictly enforced when snow removal equipment is in operation.

SNOW REMOVAL

A reminder to property owners who have a sidewalk on your property that you are responsible for keeping your sidewalk clear of snow and ice. **If it is not clear, the village employees will clear it and the cost will be billed to the property owner unless you make other arrangements** with the Village Board.

We all know that this is the time of the year for snow and ice problems on village streets. Please cooperate with County and Village employees during this winter season.

MARK THINGS BEHIND THE CURB

If you have any shrubs, fences, etc. that are close to the curb or street, please mark these things with posts and flags, so that people operating snow removal equipment will be able to identify that there is something buried under the snow to be aware of. Manitowoc County will be doing our snow plowing this year.

For safety reasons, please refrain from blowing or shoveling snow into the street. Thank you!

GARBAGE/RECYCLING

Garbage & Recycling pickup is every Tuesday. Let us know if you have any questions about garbage/recycling.

For 2021, due to Holidays, the following garbage/recycling dates will be: Memorial Day Wednesday June 2; July 4th Wednesday July 7, and Labor Day Wednesday September 8.

DOG & CAT LICENSES

Dog and cat licenses are due at this time for 2021. Certificates of current rabies vaccination must be presented when obtaining a dog or cat license. **Fee: \$5.00 for Neutered male or Spayed female; \$10.00 for Unneutered male or Unspayed female.** You can mail the rabies certificate and license fee with your tax payment, mail it separately if you do not pay a tax bill, or contact the village office. Please include a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope. **\$20.00 late fee per animal licensed after April 1, 2021.**

HOUSE NUMBERS

Please be sure that you have numbers visible on your house. This is important for emergency situations and deliveries, etc.

POLICE REPORT
