

Compost Site Guidelines

Located on the west side of N 1st Street, near Sewer Plant

PILE #1

Brush/Sticks/Branches

Drop off sticks/brush with a diameter of less than 6" and a length of 5'.

NO:

- Stumps
- Large Branches

PILE #2

Grass, Leaves and Garden Refuse

Drop your clippings and take along all garbage with you.

NO:

- Garbage
- Flower Pots
- Plastic Bags
- Brush/Sticks/Branches
- Dog Poop

\$150 Fine For:

1. Non-Resident Dumping
2. Anyone Dumping Anything Other Than Grass, Garden Wastes or Brush

What can I Recycle?

Paper

Accept:

Cardboard & Paperboard (Food Boxes)
Newspapers & Inserts
Office & School Paper
Envelopes, Junk Mail & Catalogs
Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons

Do NOT Accept:

No Paper Cups
No Shredded Paper
No Tissue Paper
No Pet Food Bags
No Takeout Pizza Boxes

Guidelines:

Cut Boxes to no larger than 2'x 2'
Take confidential papers to shred events for shredding and recycling.

Plastic

Accept:

Household Bottles, Jars & Jugs
Dairy Containers & Lids
Produce, Bakery & Deli Containers

Do NOT Accept:

No Plastic Cups & Lids
No Plastic Bags, Wraps & Films
No Motor Oil Bottles
No Styrofoam

Guidelines:

Empty, rinse and replace caps & lids

Metal & Glass

Accept:

Aluminum Bottles & Cans
Steel & Tin Cans
Glass Food & Beverage Bottles & Jars

Do NOT Accept:

No Aerosol Cans
No Propane Tanks
No Aluminum Pans or Foil
No Empty Paint Cans
No Scrap Metal
No Metal Cookware
No Mirrors
No Window Glass

Guidelines:

Empty & Rinse

PAPER
RECYCLE PAPER ITEMS LIKE NEWSPAPERS & INSERTS, OFFICE & SCHOOL PAPER, ENVELOPES, JUNK MAIL, CATALOGS, BOOKS & MAGAZINES

CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD
FLATTEN CARDBOARD BOXES AND CUT TO NO LARGER THAN 2' X 2'.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

PET: PLASTIC #1
1. Empty the container completely.
2. Rinse the container's interior.
ESPECIALLY THINGS LIKE PEANUT BUTTER & SAUCE CONTAINERS!

COLOR HDPE: PLASTIC #2
3. Replace ONLY caps on containers.
LOOSE SERIES CAPS FALL THROUGH EQUIPMENT & GET LANDFILLED!

NATURAL HDPE: PLASTIC #2

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

TIN & STEEL CANS
1. Empty the container completely.
2. Rinse the container's interior.
ESPECIALLY THINGS LIKE PET FOOD CANS & SOUP CONTAINERS!

ALUMINUM CANS
3. DO NOT CRUSH LEAD CANS AND BOTTLES IN THEIR ORIGINAL FORM TO INCREASE THEIR RECYCLING POTENTIAL.
4. Press caps into containers to increase recycling potential.
