#### PILE #1

## Brush/Sticks/Branches

Drop off sticks/brush with a diameter of less than 6" and a length of 5'.

#### NO:

- Stumps
- Large Branches

#### PILE #2

# Grass, Leaves and Garden Refuse

Drop your clippings and take along all garbage with you.

#### NO:

- Garbage
- Flower Pots
- Plastic Bags
- Brush/Sticks/Branches
- Dog Poop

## \$150 Fine For:

- 1. Non-Resident Dumping
- 2. Anyone Dumping Anything Other Than Grass, Garden Wastes or Brush

## Paper

#### Accept:

Cardboard & Paperboard (Food Boxes)
Newspapers & Inserts
Office & School Paper
Envelopes, Junk Mail & Catalogs
Milk, Juice & Soup Cartons

#### Do NOT Accept:

No Paper Cups
No Shredded Paper
No Tissue Paper
No Pet Food Bags
No Takeout Pizza Boxes

#### **Guidelines:**

Cut Boxes to no larger than 2'x 2' Take confidential papers to shred events for shredding and recycling.
